



Kids Club Competition 2017 Terms and Conditions

1. Individual entries are valid only if they meet all of the following criterion:
 - a. entries are in colour and are visible and clear (photos must be a close-up of the entry only),
 - b. artwork is based on the theme 'Extend is.....',
 - c. entry is submitted successfully by an authorised parent or guardian via official online entry form at extend.com.au,
 - d. only one entry has been submitted per child,
 - e. the child is enrolled with Extend Outside School Hours Care in 2017; and
 - f. the entry is successfully submitted via official online entry form by the closing date of 12.00pm AEST Friday 4 August, 2017.
2. By submitting the Kids Club competition 2017 online entry form, parent consent is given to Extend (Australia) Pty Ltd to upload that entry to the website and Facebook page including details of the child's full name, Extend service/school, and year level. (Parent details are kept confidential.)
3. Group entries are valid only if they meet all of the following criterion:
 - a. a mural has been created at an Extend service involving both children and Educators from that school, with the words 'Extend is...' (complete the sentence),
 - b. a clear photo has been submitted by emailing joanne@extend.com.au
 - c. only one entry has been submitted per school,
 - d. the photo entry is submitted by 12.00pm AEST Friday 4 August, 2017.
5. All valid entries may be used for marketing purposes in public forums or social media sites eg. online publications, Facebook, Twitter, etc. In addition to this, each prize winner's photograph may be used for marketing purposes in public forums.
6. All valid individual entries will be judged by a representative of Extend (Australia) Pty Ltd according to the child's year level. The selection of shortlisted entries is at the discretion of the representative.
7. Online votes are open to the public on Monday 14 August 2017, 9.00am AEST to Friday 1 September 2017, 12.00pm AEST and are valid one vote per person.
